PARISH COUNCIL MEETINGS

TWO DEFIBRILLATORS FOR KELLINGTON

The Parish Council is supportive of the fund-raising being carried out by the staff and customers of the Red Lion to purchase a defibrillator for that end of our village and we want to see another one sited at the Village Hall.

(A defibrillator is a device that gives a high energy electric shock to the heart through the chest wall to someone who is in cardiac arrest. – and when they are used quickly they save lives)

Two Defibrillators would ensure they would be handy to help ALL residents and the one at the Village Hall would also be close to the major employment sites: Poskitts and Meadow Lodge

So, would YOU like to donate to a fund to get these two defibrillators for Kellington?

DOG FOULING

We continue to receive complaints about dog fouling, even on the play park where it could be a very serious health issue to the children who use it. The majority of dog owners do 'pick up'. You can deposit your dog bags in any of the litter bins not just the dog bins.

Because of our many litter bins and the residents who litter pick Kellington is a very clean village, blighted by dog mess. Please BAG IT and put it in a bin!

Over the last few years we have put in new litter bins and many residents regularly pick up litter on our lanes and roads.

There is NO excuse for fly tipping. Selby Council will, for a price, collect bulky items or you can take them, for free, to the civic amenity site;
