## NOISE NUISANCE COMPLAINT – POSKITTS LTD

Selby District Council have now concluded their investigations into the complaint of noise nuisance from operations at Poskitts Ltd.

They have stated that "they are of the opinion that the noise does not amount to a statutory nuisance". They have reached this conclusion having taken several factors into account including : loudness, time of day, duration and frequency of noise and character of neighbourhood.

Poskitts had made an application for planning permission to erect an acoustic fence but this application has now been withdrawn.

## KELLINGTON DEFIBRILLATORS

## DEFIBRILLATOR AWARENESS SESSION

Steve Parker will be there to explain how easy it is to use a defibrillator, how it could help you to save a life or indeed help someone else to save your life!

The Kellington defibrillators are linked to the **Yorkshire Ambulance Service**. When a 999 call is made, if a defibrillator is needed, the caller will be given the key code number to access the nearest one.
