## **KNOTTINGLEY POWER**

Gas fired power station – this is now on hold as they failed to get the go-ahead at the 2018 Energy Capacity Auction. Although they have bought the site and will shortly have full control of it they WILL NOT be building a gas fired power station there any time soon.

# **PLANNING**

The planning application to build a new residential development to the rear of Manor Garth and the school was REFUSED by Selby Planning Committee on Wednesday April 11<sup>th</sup>. The reasons for the refusal were that the arrangements for dealing with ground water were inadequate, it is outside the village development limits and it would adversely affect the views, landscape, character and setting of Kellington.

The applicant can appeal the decision.
