An issue was raised about the flood water running off the fields onto the road on Low Lane. It was stated that the drains had worked well in taking the water away.

A comment was made that the height of the flood bank was increased after the 2000 floods.

Concerns were expressed about the A19 being closed and a comment was made that the road has been wearing for several years.

Contact is to be made with the Environment Agency urging them to take action regarding the following issues:

- Flooding inside the flood barrier on Ings Lane and the gardens of properties on Water Garth.
- The steps leading over the bank at the corner of Ings Lane and Bird Lane have become dangerous. These steps have been reported previously
