The largest area of spending was for grass cutting, including the Churchyard, and hanging baskets which totalled £5,538.93. Of this amount £299.04 has been recouped from North Yorkshire County Council, this has been the same amount for the last 4 years.

The second largest area of spend was for the maintenance of the streetlights and the electricity supply. The total cost was $\pounds 3,491.60$.

The insurance costs associated with the Parish Council and village hall total £1691.80.

Staffing costs in this financial year have totalled £1,857.72.

There were no local events due to covid19, but a Christmas tree was purchased at a cost of ± 135.00 . ± 163.00 was paid for newsletters and leaflets.

£500.00 was given in grants.

The VAT claim to be submitted for the period 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021 is for a total of $\pounds 806.64$.

The amount of precept payable from SDC was £16,123.72.

There are a number of projects which need to be carried out in 2021/22 and although the financial position continues to be very good careful management of the budgets will need to continue in 2021-22.
